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Summer Agriculture Institute (SAI) is a project supported by the Oregon Agricultural Education Foundation. Participants receive **3 graduate level credits (equivalent to 60 PDUs)**, AED 518, through Oregon State University.

A \$600.00 registration fee per participant is required (Non-refundable after June 2<sup>nd</sup>). Fee includes OSU tuition, hotel accommodations, meals, transportation for the weeklong activities, curriculum, resources, and classroom kits.

Once application is accepted, applicant must submit a Graduate Non-Degree Admit Application with \$35 fee to OSU
