

## HAVE YOU SEEN KINCAID'S LUPINE?

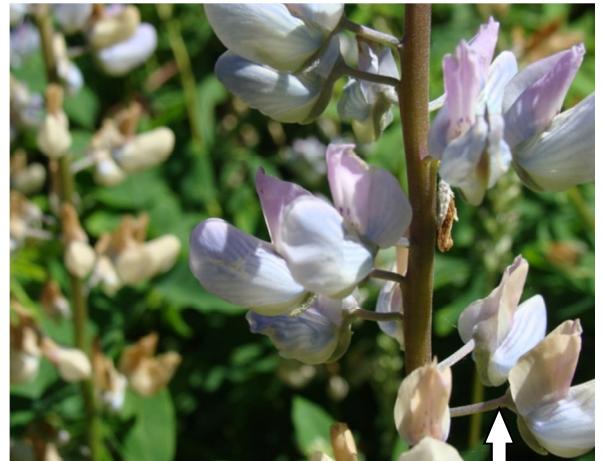


Notice pinched and ruffled top petal (banner)

### Kincaid's Lupine (*Lupinus oreganus*)

- Leaflets are smooth on the upper side, pubescent on the underside
- Leaflets are thin and creased down the middle, less than 6 cm long
- Large space between flower whorls
- Flower banner is pinched & ruffled
- Flowers turn brown quickly
- Stinky! Smells like a mix of grape jam & dirty socks

Note that banner is pressed together but lacks pinch & ruffle of Kincaids
