

Wildlife Cover Boards at Miller Woods

When visiting Miller Woods it can be fun to examine some of our Wildlife Cover Boards. The boards have a wood frame and have a handle so you can lift and see what critters may be underneath! Reptiles, amphibians, and/or small mammals often use the boards to stay cool or to hide from predators.

The map shows the location of the eleven Wildlife Cover Boards. Use the animal descriptions and the photos linked in the QR code to identify the reptiles hiding under or around the boards. Remember, though, that animals may not always be present.
